

Tree Damage from last July's storm

Now is the time to order replacement and conservation trees for spring planting. Many trees were damaged by the storm last July and while many trees will survive some will need to be replaced. Farmstead windbreaks hit hardest by the storm were damaged to the point they need to be cleared and replanted. The LqP SWCD has several cost share programs available to help with the cost of replacing ineffective and damaged windbreaks. Individual trees used for conservation and windbreak replacements should be ordered soon to guarantee the trees you want are available.
