The Walk-In Access program which provides hunters quality hunting opportunities on private land is wrapping up its first successful year with many hunters using the new hunting areas. The second year of the program will have a couple of changes along with CREP, CRP, WRP, and RIM acres the program will also allow non-program acres to be enrolled as long as they provide quality wildlife cover over 40 acres. Fewer acres may be enrolled if they are adjacent to other areas open to public hunting.
