Actual Results

Staff reviewed 205 drainage permit applications for wetland impacts and informed applicants of options and/or restrictions. Staff reviewed and approved credit release requests for two wetland banks following site visit confirmations. One of the requests was a final request following staff approval of the final delineation. One Ag Bank mitigation exemption submitted in 2021 was approved by the LGU in 2022. One No-Loss application was submitted and approved provided the applicant follows conditions recommended by the TEP. Staff informed 3 landowners DNR permits would be required for their proposed activities. Staff assisted 3 landowners with questions about potential bank sites. Staff assisted landowners with numerous additional inquiries, including watering hole excavation, berm creation, and mitigation process, among others: \$3,274.18
